HYscent Perfumers combine fragrance ingredients to create a scent. They select from our approved palette of materials, which can include ingredients that are:

- Naturally occurring, meaning extracted from plants and flowers
- Nature-identical, meaning synthetic materials used to take the place of naturals where allergens within the naturals can cause serious human side effects. In addition, they are used to provide consistent quality and safety, but are made in a laboratory

## Safety & Quality Assurance

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For the HYscent fragrance ingredient palette, we require that any fragrance materials our perfumers use meet the **Research Institute for Fragrance Materials (RIFM)** and the **International Fragrance Association (IFRA)** standards.

HYscent perfumers adhere to the standards set by the **Research Institute for Fragrance Materials (RIFM)**, which has the most comprehensive database worldwide of safety evaluations for fragrance materials. It's an industry organization, and it uses an independent expert panel. Industry safety standards are maintained by IFRA, using data from RIFM.

We require our fragrance suppliers to abide by IFRA's Code of Practice and its standards, which take into account numerous factors including chemical composition, variety of use, volume of use, usage concentration and more. The IFRA standards currently restrict the use of more than 170 substances due to their chemical profile.
